## Praise Report: Praise God for the success of our Outreach to Fidiwo.

We thank you all for your prayers and gift support for volunteers who participated in the outreach to Fidiwo and the surrounding villages last month. The Lord went before them to prepare villagers hearts to receive the gospel message and be blessed by the medical outreach and counselling from the ministry team. We have many pictures and audio testimonies that we couldn't share in this newsletter, but there were two highlights that we must share with you.

The first is how much your gifts matter in outreaches to remote villages such as Fidiwo. The young people who volunteer their time to take the Gospel and relief materials to villages are encouraged to serve the Lord because they know

there are people who have their back with prayers and monetary support. They do not have to worry about transportation and sometimes make some decisions on the spot to provide for the needs of the people they are ministering to. We have an example from this outreach. During one of the one-on-one breakout sessions, a young volunteer had one of the teenagers confide in her on how she could not afford ₦200 (approx. US \$0.15) to buy medication that she needed. The volunteer immediately gave her that money, knowing that she would be reimbursed by her supervisor.

The second highlight in the report is concerning and requires your prayer support. As a result of the weekly follow-up visits to the villages after the major outreach, some of the young people (including 15-year-olds and under) developed a relationship of trust with our volunteers. They shared some confidential information that they would otherwise not share with anybody. That included cases of sexual abuse and sexually transmitted diseases (involving both male and female victims) that require medical attention. We take these reports seriously, and we are taking steps to find solutions to these problems while protecting the interests of the victims and helping them to grow in their new faith. We ask for your continued prayers and support for the workers who volunteer their time and skills to attend to the needy villagers, and also for the villagers of all generations who welcome our workers to their villages and open up their hearts to receive the Gospel message.
